Just like our most of hardback books, your book should have a book cover, or a "Book Jacket". Your book jacket can be made out of any type of paper you want. There should be a picture, the author and the illustrator on the front cover. You should include a small paragraph about the story on the inside flap of your cover. Your back flap should include "all about the author". Tell who the author is, where they live, why they write children's books and any information you may think in interesting. You can find all of this information (and much more) on the Internet. On the back cover of your book jacket, you should tell why you recommend this book to your friends.

Be sure to use "reach out and grab me" words. Make it fun and exciting and make the book jacket so creative that I will want to read your book.
